- ✓ We strive to provide you with a healthy pet and promote a healthy pet relationship. Please watch for signs of stress from changing environments, which can lower an animal’s immunity to fight disease. See your vet at first signs of illness.
 - ✓ We ask that you respond to our efforts to check on your adoption progress and share your success.
 - ✓ We recognize some pet matches may not be successful through no fault of the person or the pet. We will welcome you and your returned pet if all efforts fail to establish a healthy bond.
 - Hides much longer than expected after meeting its new family home.
 - Shows worsening signs of stress, stops eating, loses weight, bites or growls.
 - Refuses to use the litter boxes or suddenly starts spraying.

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1. I am 18 years of age or older.
2. I agree to be responsible for the care of the cats and kittens I have adopted, including:
 - a. nutritious food, fresh water, fresh air, exercise, appropriate shelter
 - b. a humane environment providing protection from neglect, abuse, and undue exposure to possible harm or cruelty
 - c. socializing the cat with people and other animals if possible, providing opportunities for companionship, playful fun, love and affection
 - d. seeking veterinary care when they are sick or injured to prevent suffering
 - e. keeping them protected against rabies and abiding by animal control laws
3. I will not declaw any cat in my care, ever.
